

The ASE requests listed companies to file the annual financial statements of 2024 before the end of the specified date

Mr. Mazen Wathaifi the Chief Executive Officer of Amman Stock Exchange (ASE) said that the ASE requests listed companies to submit their audited annual financial statements reports for the period ended December 31, 2024, through the e-disclosure System XBRL, prior to the end of Sunday 06/04/2025, in line with the Jordan Securities Commission's decision to extend the legal deadline for submitting the 2024 annual reports until 06/04/2025, due to the coincidence of the annual report submission deadline with the Eid al-Fitr holiday.

Accordingly, the ASE will suspend trading in shares of the violating company as of the first working day following the above-mentioned deadline until it provides the ASE with the required reports by virtue of Article (15/B/6) of the Listing Directives. The aim of requiring listed companies to provide the ASE with information and annual reports on timely basis is to enhance the protection of investors, transparency and disclosure in the capital market, and provide investors with the companies' information and results during the fiscal year. The ASE circulates these reports on the ASE website www.exchange.jo under the Circulars and Disclosures/ annual reports window to be reachable for those interested.

Moreover, the ASE will announce through media the violating companies' names which didn't submit their audited annual reports within the specified period.
